ADJUDICATION

BACKGROUND:

The Bureau of Liquor Control Enforcement of the Pennsylvania State Police issued this citation on September 19, 2005. The citation alleges that Licensee violated §493(26) of the Liquor Code, 47 P.S. §4-493(26), by issuing checks or drafts dated June 24 and 26, 2005, in payment for purchases of malt or brewed beverages, when there were insufficient funds in, or credit with, the institution upon which drawn for the payment of such checks.

At the hearing scheduled for December 8, 2005, in Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania, there was no appearance for the Licensee; therefore, the matter proceeded *ex parte*.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The Bureau investigated Licensee during the period July 25 through August 12, 2005, and sent written notice of the results of its investigation to the licensed premises by certified mail on August 22, 2005 (N.T. 7-8, Exhibit B-1).

2. A copy of this citation was mailed to the licensed establishment by certified mail on September 19, 2005 (N.T. 8, Exhibit B-2).

3. A Notice of Hearing was mailed to the licensed establishment by the Office of Administrative Law Judge, Harrisburg, PA, by certified and first class mail on October 21, 2005.

4. Joseph Ryan is the customer relations specialist at Penn Distributors, Inc., a licensed distributor. Records in his custody show a delivery of malt and brewed beverages to Licensee on June 24, 2005, and an amount due of \$2,099.40. Licensee gave a check for that amount, which was dishonored on presentation due to insufficient funds. The check was deposited again, and cleared (N.T. 13-14).

5. William Conwell is the office manager of Muller, Inc., a licensed distributor. Records in his custody show a delivery of malt and brewed beverages to Licensee on June 26, 2005, and an amount due of \$1,672.05. Licensee gave a check for that amount, which was dishonored on presentation due to insufficient funds. The check was deposited again, and cleared (N.T. 9-12).

6. On March 18, 2005, the Bureau issued a written warning to Licensee concerning previous bad checks to the same distributors in the same calendar year (Exhibit B-5).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Sustained as charged.

PRIOR RECORD:

Licensee has been licensed since April 29, 1999, and has had prior violations, as follows:

2. Purchased malt or brewed beverages after distributor license expired. November 5, 19, 22, 24, 26, December 17, 21, 22 and 23, 2004.
3. Sold malt or brewed beverages after distributor license expired. February 2, 2005.

Citation No. 05-0663. \$200.00 fine.

1. Purchased malt or brewed beverages after distributor license expired. January 28, 2005.

Citation No. 05-1056. \$200.00 fine.

1. Bad checks for malt or brewed beverages. February 11, March 4 and 18, 2005.

Citation No. 05-1345. \$400.00 fine.

1. Bad checks for malt or brewed beverages. April 14, 2005.

PENALTY:

Section 471 of the Liquor Code, 47 P.S. §4-471, prescribes a penalty of license suspension or revocation or a fine in the \$50.00 to \$1,000.00 range, or both, for violations of the type found in this case.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Licensee, RB Adhuria, Inc., License No. D-SS-925, pay a fine of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) within 20 days of the mailing date of this order. In the event the fine is not paid within 20 days, Licensee's license will be suspended or revoked. Jurisdiction is retained.

The fine must be paid by treasurer's check, cashier's check, certified check or money order. **Personal checks, which include business-use personal checks, are not acceptable.** Please make your guaranteed check payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and mail to:
