ADJUDICATION

BACKGROUND:

This proceeding arises out of a citation that was issued on April 5, 2007, by the Bureau of Liquor Control Enforcement of the Pennsylvania State Police (hereinafter "Bureau") against JOHN R. MARTIN, License Number ID-SS-502 (hereinafter "Licensee").

The citation charges Licensee with violation of Section 493(26) of the Liquor Code [47 P.S. §4-493(26)] in that Licensee, by his servants, agents or employes, issued checks or drafts dated December 30, 2006 and January 22, 2007 in payment for purchases of malt or brewed beverages, when he had insufficient funds in, or credit with, the institution upon which drawn for the payment of such checks.

The investigation which gave rise to the citation began on January 19, 2007 and was completed on February 23, 2007; and notice of the violation was sent to Licensee by Certified Mail on March 7, 2007. The notice of violation was received by Licensee.

An evidentiary hearing was held on this matter on July 26, 2007 in the PA Department of Agriculture, 2130 County Farms Road, Montoursville, Pennsylvania. No one appeared at the hearing on behalf of Licensee. A citation hearing notice was sent to Licensee(s) at his address of record, 334 N. Williamson Rd., Blossburg, PA 16912-1211 by certified mail, return receipt requested and by first class mail on June 11, 2006. The notice set forth the date and time of the hearing as July 26, 2007 at 11:00 a.m., and the place of hearing as PA Dept. of Agriculture, 2130 County Farms Road, Montoursville, PA 17754-9685.

Upon review of the transcript of this hearing, we make the following Findings of Fact and reach the following Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. On December 30, 2006 Licensee purchased malt or brewed beverages from Mid State Beverage Co. In payment therefore, Licensee issued its check in the amount of \$3,771.25. The check was returned by Licensee's bank for insufficient funds (N.T. 8-9 and Exhibit C-5).

2. On January 22, 2007 Licensee purchased malt or brewed beverages from Mid State Beverage Co. In payment therefore, Licensee issued its check in the amount of \$3,261.85. The check was returned by Licensee's bank for insufficient funds (N.T. 10-11 and Exhibit C-6).

3. Licensee was warned by letter dated March 24, 2006 concerning an NSF check issued to Mid State Beverage Co. on January 30, 2006 in payment for malt or brewed beverages. The check was in the amount of \$5,097.00 (N.T. 11 and Exhibit C-7).

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

The charge in the citation is **sustained**.

PENALTY:

Section 471 of the Liquor Code [47 P.S. §4-471] prescribes a penalty of license suspension or revocation or a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$1,000.00 or both for violations of the type found in this case.

Under the circumstances of this case, the penalty imposed shall be a fine of \$350.00.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Licensee JOHN R. MARTIN, pay a fine of \$350.00 within 20 days of the mailing date of this Order. In the event the aforementioned fine is not paid within 20 days from the mailing date of this Order, Licensee's license shall be suspended or revoked.

Jurisdiction is retained pending final resolution of the penalty in this matter.
