**ADJUDICATION**

BACKGROUND:

This proceeding arises out of a citation that was issued on November 19, 2008, by the Bureau of Liquor Control Enforcement of the Pennsylvania State Police (hereinafter "Bureau") against MALT, LTD., License Number R-AP-SS-EHF-17643 (hereinafter "Licensee").

The citation charges Licensee with violation of Sections 491(1), 492(2) and 493(16) of the Liquor Code [47 P.S. §§4-491(1), 4-492(2) and 4-493(16)] in that on October 1, 2008, Licensee, by its servants, agents or employees, sold alcoholic beverages after the Restaurant Liquor License expired on September 30, 2008, and had not been renewed and/or validated.

The investigation which gave rise to the citation began on October 1, 2008 and was completed on October 22, 2008; and notice of the violation was sent to Licensee by Certified Mail on October 29, 2008. The notice of violation was received by Licensee.

An evidentiary hearing was held on this matter on March 19, 2008 in the Scranton State Office Building, 100 Lackawanna Avenue, Scranton, Pennsylvania. No one appeared at the hearing on behalf of Licensee. A citation hearing notice was sent to Licensee(s) at its address of record, 518 N. Main St., Old Forge, PA 18518-1812 by certified mail, return receipt requested and by first class mail on January 29, 2009. The notice set forth the date and time of the hearing as March 19, 2009 at 2:30 p.m., and the place of hearing as PUC Hearing Room 318, 100 Lackawanna Avenue, Scranton PA 18503.

Upon review of the transcript of this hearing, we make the following Findings of Fact and reach the following Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Administrative notice is hereby taken that Licensee's restaurant liquor license expired on September 30, 2008, and, as of October 1, 2008, it had not been renewed or validated, and Licensee did not have authority to dispense alcoholic beverages.
2. On October 1, 2008 at 5:45 p.m. an officer of the Bureau visited the licensed premises. He found three patrons seated at the bar each of whom possessed a different brand of beer (N.T. 7).
3. At that time the officer ordered and was served a bottle of Yuengling Lager beer for which he was charged \$1.25 by a female bartender (N.T. 7).

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

The charge in the citation is **sustained**.

1. Issued worthless checks in payment for purchases of malt or brewed beverages. August 28, 2008.

PENALTY:

Section 471 of the Liquor Code [47 P.S. §4-471] prescribes a penalty of license suspension or revocation or a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00 or both for violations of the type found in this case.

This office takes notice that Licensee's license has previously been revoked.

Under the circumstances of this case, the penalty imposed shall be revocation.

ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Liquor License No. R-AP-SS-17643, issued to MALT, LTD., be **REVOKED** effective at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, July 20, 2009. Any Wholesale Liquor Purchase Permit Card or discount card issued in connection with the aforementioned license is hereby CANCELLED.

Since the license is already revoked there is no license to return; therefore, the Bureau of Licensing is hereby directed to mark their records that this license has been **REVOKED**. The Licensee's right to renew his license is hereby CANCELLED.

Jurisdiction is retained pending final resolution of the penalty in this matter.
