CORRECTED ORDER

The decision of the ALJ is affirmed.

The appeal of Licensee is dismissed.

Licensee has paid the fine in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

It is further ordered that Licensee's Restaurant Liquor License No. R-3050 be suspended for a period of three (3) days, beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, January 3, 2011 and ending at 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 6, 2011.

It is further ordered that Licensee must remain in compliance with the requirements set forth in section 471.1 of the Liquor Code [47 P.S. § 471.1] pertaining to Responsible Alcohol Management until November 5, 2011.

Licensee must adhere to all other conditions set forth in the ALJ's Order mailed November 9, 2010.
