**OPINION AND ORDER UPON
LICENSEE'S FAILURE TO PAY FINE**

Opinion:

On October 7, 2019, I issued an Adjudication, as above docketed, in which I imposed a \$1,650.00 fine. The fine was to be paid on or before October 28, 2019. Licensee did not pay that fine. Consequently, pursuant to Liquor Code Section 471(b) [47 P.S. §4-471(b)], I must suspend or revoke the license.

I take Official Notice (40 Pa. Code §15.52) that, since August 31, 2019, the license has not been renewed.

Order:

I suspend the license indefinitely for at least one day, as well as all other permits or licenses issued by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board attendant to the license, until I issue a further Order terminating the suspension. As the license has been not been renewed since August 31, 2019, I defer the suspension. If the license is renewed, I will issue an Order imposing the suspension.


I direct the Licensing Bureau, PLCB, to notify the Office of Administrative Law Judge if the license is renewed.

If Licensee fails to pay the fine within sixty days of the mailing date of this Order, I will then determine what further action I need to take which will likely include revoking the license. The mailing date is located in the upper left corner of the immediately preceding page.

In the event Licensee does not comply with all conditions herein, the Bureau may issue an additional citation claiming Licensee has violated this Opinion and Order. Alternatively, the Bureau may assert the same claim by requesting this Opinion and Order be reopened.

I retain Jurisdiction to ensure compliance with this Opinion and Order.
