**OPINION AND ORDER UPON LICENSEE'S
FAILURE TO PAY FINE WITHIN SIXTY DAYS**

Opinion:

On October 7, 2019, I issued an Adjudication, as above docketed, in which I imposed a \$1,650.00 fine. The fine was to be paid on or before October 28, 2019. Licensee did not pay that fine.

On November 20, 2019, I issued an Opinion and Order Upon Licensee's Failure To Pay Fine, as above docketed, in which I suspended the license for one day and continuing thereafter until Licensee paid a fine of \$1,650.00. The suspension was deferred pending license renewal.

The Opinion and Order Upon Licensee's Failure To Pay Fine further stated that, if the fine was not paid within sixty days of November 20, 2019, I would determine what further action needed to be taken which would likely be revoking the license.

As the sixty days period has elapsed and Licensee has not paid the fine, I enter the following Order:


Order:

I revoke the license and any permit or other authority issued by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board attendant to the license.

Since the license is out of existence, there is no license to be returned. Therefore, the Bureau of Licensing of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board is directed to mark their records accordingly, that this license will be revoked, effective, Monday, March 16, 2020.

I retain Jurisdiction to ensure compliance with this Opinion and Order.
