**OPINION AND ORDER UPON
LICENSEE'S FINE PAYMENT**

Background:

On October 7, 2019, I issued an Adjudication, as above docketed, in which I imposed a \$1,650.00 fine. The fine was to be paid on or before October 28, 2019. Licensee did not pay that fine.

On November 20, 2019, I issued an Opinion and Order Upon Licensee's Failure To Pay Fine, as above docketed, in which I suspended the license for one day and continuing thereafter until Licensee paid a fine of \$1,650.00. The suspension was deferred pending license renewal.

On February 5, 2020, I issued an Opinion and Order Upon Licensee's Failure To Pay Fine Within Sixty Days, as above docketed, in which I revoked the license, effective March 16, 2020.

On February 7, 2020, Licensee paid the fine.


As Licensee has paid the fine, I vacate the revocation and thereafter suspension. When the license is renewed, I will issue an order imposing the one day suspension.

Order:

The license revocation for failure to pay fine, effective March 16, 2020, is vacated.

I retain Jurisdiction to ensure compliance with this Opinion and Order.
