**Re: Permission to Sell Lottery Tickets**

Dear Mr. Cipolla:

ISSUE: This is in response to your letter dated February 10, 2014, in which you request permission to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets in your licensed establishment.

Records of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board ("Board") indicate that Anthony's Place Enterprise Inc., holds Restaurant Liquor License No. R-12418 (LID 69191) for the premises located at 919 Pennsylvania Avenue, Monaca, Pennsylvania.

OPINION: Generally, section 3.52 of the Board's Regulations prohibits a licensee from operating or permitting another person to operate another business on a licensed premises without Board approval. [40 Pa. Code § 3.52].

However, the Board has traditionally granted retail licensees' requests to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets on their licensed premises. Therefore, your request to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets on your licensed premises is granted, provided that you comply with any rules or regulations imposed by the Pennsylvania Lottery.
