**E: Bulletin Board in Bar Area**

Dear Mr. Killinger and Ms. Vangorder:

ISSUE: This office is in receipt of your e-mail dated March 6, 2015, wherein you inquire if there are any prohibitions or restrictions as to the placement of a bulletin board in the bar area.

Records of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (“Board”) indicate that Valley Hotel, Inc. holds Hotel Liquor License No. H-2620 (LID 43289) for premises located at 240-246 Main Street, Mill Hall, Pennsylvania.

OPINION: Neither the Liquor Code nor the Board’s Regulations prohibit the placement of a bulletin board in an area of the bar. Further, there are no stipulations pertaining to its use.

THIS OPINION APPLIES ONLY TO THE FACTUAL SITUATION DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DOES NOT INSULATE THE LICENSEE OR OTHERS FROM CONSEQUENCES OF CONDUCT OCCURRING PRIOR TO ITS ISSUANCE. THE PROPRIETY OF THE PROPOSED CONDUCT HAS BEEN ADDRESSED ONLY UNDER THE LIQUOR CODE AND REGULATIONS. THE LAWS AND POLICIES ON WHICH THIS OPINION IS BASED ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE LEGISLATURE OR THE PENNSYLVANIA LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.
