RE: Permission to Sell Lottery Tickets

Dear Mr. Wolowski:

ISSUE: This is in response to your letter dated September 25, 2015, in which you request permission for Giant Eagle, Inc. to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets in its licensed establishment. Records of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board ("Board") indicate that Giant Eagle, Inc. holds Restaurant Liquor License No. R-10303 (LID 63251) for the premises located at 910 Freeport Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

OPINION: Generally, section 3.52 of the Board's Regulations prohibits a licensee from operating or permitting another person to operate another business on a licensed premises without Board approval. [40 Pa. Code § 3.52].

However, the Board has traditionally granted retail licensees' requests to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets on their licensed premises. Therefore, your request to sell Pennsylvania lottery tickets on your licensed premises is granted, provided that you comply with any rules or regulations imposed by the Pennsylvania Lottery.
