**RE: Sale of Wine to Bars and Taverns in New York**

Dear Ms. Hall:

ISSUE: This is in response to your e-mail of December 14, 2015, wherein you state that you own a small winery in Pennsylvania and inquire if you are permitted to sell your wine to bars and taverns in New York.

Records of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (“Board”) indicate that Red Bandana Winery, LLC, holds Limited Winery License No. LK-338 (LID 65552) for use by it at 265 Allio Drive, Leeper, Pennsylvania.

OPINION: The Liquor Code and the Regulations of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board do not regulate the export of alcohol from Pennsylvania to other states, U.S. territories, or foreign countries. The Board is unable to offer guidance with respect to other states’ alcoholic beverage importation laws. As such, it is suggested that you contact New York, the receiving state, for its laws regarding your proposed sale of wine.
