**RE: Distillery Shipping Out of State**

Dear Mr. Griffin:

ISSUE: This office is in receipt of your e-mail dated February 4, 2016, in which you ask for guidance on how to ship liquor out of state from your distillery.

Records of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (“PLCB”) indicate that The Griffin Method, Inc., trading as Griffin Whiskey, is the holder of Limited Distillery License No. AL-57 (LID 71977) for use at the premises located at 4996 Brush Valley Road, Rebersburg, Pennsylvania.

OPINION: The Liquor Code and Board’s Regulations do not regulate the exportation of alcohol from Pennsylvania to other states, U.S. territories or foreign countries. Exporting liquor from Pennsylvania to another state or country would require compliance with the requirements of that state or country. Contacting the appropriate liquor regulatory agency in the receiving state or country would be advisable.
