**OPINION:** This office has reviewed the proposed promotion (and accompanying point-of-sale materials) and determined that it comports with applicable liquor laws and regulations, specifically 493(24) of the Liquor Code. [47 P.S. Section 4-493(24)]. Therefore, it is permissible to conduct such event(s) in the Commonwealth on the areas checked below:

- retail licensed premises.
- distributor licensed premises.
- both retail and distributor licensed premises.
- wine & spirit shoppes, subject to approval of Bureau of Logistics.
