[47 P.S. Section 4-493(24)]. Therefore, it is permissible to conduct such event(s) in the Commonwealth on the areas checked below:

retail licensed premises.

distributor licensed premises.

both retail and distributor licensed
premises.

wine & spirits shoppes, subject to the approval of
the Bureau of Logistics.
