**RE: Tequiza Point-of-Sale**

Dear Ms. Rabe:

**ISSUE:** This is in response to your inquiry of April 7, 1999 to this office in which you request approval of a point-of-sale item as described in the enclosed correspondence.

**OPINION:** This office has reviewed the proposed point-of-sale item and determined that it comports with applicable liquor laws and regulations, specifically section 493(20)(i) of the Liquor Code. [47 P.S. Section 4-493(20)(i)]. Therefore, it is permissible to utilize this point-of-sale item in conjunction with the above-referenced promotion at:

- retail licensed premises.
- distributor licensed premises.
- both retail and distributor licensed premises.
- wine & spirit shoppes, subject to approval of Bureau of Logistics.
- You are cautioned that neither the meal nor the drink may be discounted. [40 Pa. Code Section 13.102].

THIS OPINION APPLIES ONLY TO THE FACTUAL SITUATION DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DOES NOT INSULATE THE LICENSEE OR OTHERS FROM CONSEQUENCES OF CONDUCT OCCURRING PRIOR TO ITS ISSUANCE. THE PROPRIETY OF THE PROPOSED CONDUCT HAS BEEN ADDRESSED ONLY UNDER THE LIQUOR CODE AND REGULATIONS. THE LAWS AND POLICIES ON WHICH THIS OPINION IS BASED ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE LEGISLATURE OR THE PENNSYLVANIA LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.
